

**ASBESTOS INSPECTION
2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR**

AHREA is a federal law enacted in 1987, which requires all school districts to re-inspect facilities for building materials containing asbestos. Our facilities have been inspected and response actions are planned to ensure a continued safe environment for our students and employees.

Activities include training of the maintenance staff to prevent disturbance of asbestos and periodic re-inspection and surveillance by trained personnel. Details of such activities are described in the AHREA Management Plan, which is available for your review in the District Office.
